Let us cherish the dream of transforming this college into an ideal institution of higher education in the forthcoming days.

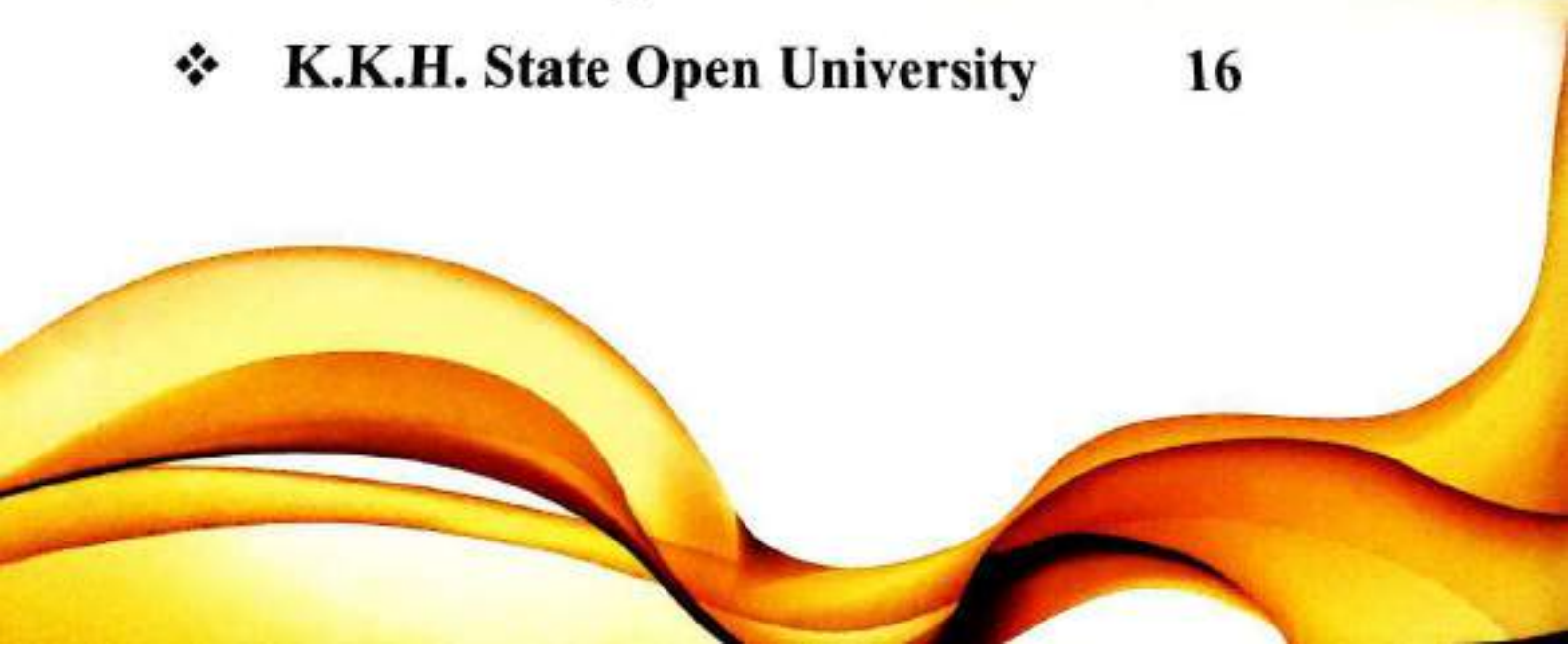

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COLLEGE PROFILE

A. LOCATION :

Sarupathar College is the premier institution of higher education in the greater Dhansiri Sub-Division of Golaghat district along the Assam Nagaland border which covers an area of 888 sq. km. Embellished by its diverse ethnic groups with their rich cultural heritage, this region can aptly be called Assam in miniature. The river Dhansiri flows 2 km. west from the college and the river Doyang flows 6 km. east from the college. The college is situated at a distance of 55 km. to the south of the district headquarters at Golaghat, bounded by unbroken chain of the Naga Hills to the south-east and south and the Karbi Hills to the west. Located at Naharani at the outskirts of the town this college is at a distance of about 3 km. from Sarupathar Railway Station (NF Railway)

B. HISTORY :

Established on November 14th in the year 1970 with Mr. Muhi Kanta Tamuly as its Principal, Sarupathar College is the outcome of toil and hardship of a host of leading personalities of the greater Sarupathar area, who had been longing to see the light of higher education in this outlying remote part of the country. The dream was realized with conviction when the college was brought under deficit grants by the Assam government in 1981. Thus, a new era dawned on this premier educational institution not without tremendous perils and sacrifice faced by some of the founder teachers and well wishers. Today the college owes much to the local community who had contributed so much to see the college where it stands today. At the same time the college stands faithful to its commitment by giving her very best in the field of higher education. On the other hand, the introduction of the Commerce Stream in the year 1985 was another feather to the cap. Optional Subjects : (any three) Economics, Salesmanship and Advertising, Commercial Arithmetic and Elements of Statistics. Besides the optional subjects, students can take one more subject as the 4th subject.

VI. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Eligibility Criteria :

ADMISSION WILL BE CONDUCTED PURELY ON THE BASIS OF MARKS OBTAINED BY STUDENTS IN THE LAST EXAMINATION APPEARED.

(a) **Bachelor of Arts (B.A.)** : A student who has passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) of the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council, or an equivalent examination (10+2) recognised by University, shall be eligible for admission into the First Semester of the Six Semester Degree Course in Arts in Semester System.

(b) **Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com)** : A student who has passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in Commerce shall be eligible for admission into the First Semester of the Six Semester Degree Course in Commerce in Semester System.

(i) Application for admission into the college should be made in the prescribed application form issued by the college office on payment of Rs. 150.00 being the cost for admission form and prospectus cum academic Calender.

(ii) Admission to the college is made strictly in order of merit and is governed by college admission rules.

(iii) Candidates are required to produce at the time of admission the original copies of mark sheet of the last qualifying examination. They should produce the following documents apart from the marksheet :

- ◆ Age certificate
- ◆ Character certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended
- ◆ Caste certificate where necessary.
- ◆ Two copies of passport size photograph.

C) Number of Seats in Different Courses

- (i) H.S. 1st year (Arts) : 200 seats
- (ii) H.S. 1st year (Commerce) : 200 seats
- (iii) B.A. 1st Semester : 300 seats
- (iv) B.Com 1st Semester : 150 seats

RULES AND REGULATIONS

(a) Attendance

(i) A student who has less than 80% attendance shall not be permitted to sit for the End Semester examination in the course in which the shortfall exists.

However, it shall be open to the University to grant exemption to student who has attended a minimum of 70% classes but failed to obtain the prescribed 80% attendance for valid reasons on recommendation of the Head of the institution on payment of prescribed fee(s).

(ii) The Principal of the college/ institution with recommendation of the Heads of the Department shall announce the names of all students who shall not be eligible to appear in the End Semester examination due to non-fulfilment of the criteria of internal assessment and attendance, and send a copy of the same to the University. In such cases, the student shall have to re-enroll in the relevant course(s) with the next batch.

(b) Examination and Evaluation

(i) Examination and evaluation shall be done from time to time.

(ii) There shall be 20% marks for internal assessment and 80% marks for End Semester examination in each course during every semester.

(iii) There shall be no provision for re-evaluation of the answer-scripts of the End Semester examinations. However, a candidate may apply for re-scrutiny.

(c) Internal Assessment

(i) In internal assessment, different tools may be employed such as written tests, assignments, paper presentation, laboratory work, etc. as demanded by the course. The procedure for Internal Assessment will be as per the guidelines of Dibrugarh University.

(ii) The students shall be informed in advance about the nature of assessment. They shall compulsorily attend the process of internal assessment, failing which they will not be allowed to appear in the End Semester examination. A student cannot repeat In-Semester examinations. However, if a student fails to appear in any of the In-Semester examination on valid reasons, the department concerned may arrange special in-semester examination.

(d) End Semester Examination

(i) There shall be one End Semester examination carrying 80% marks in each course of a Semester covering the entire syllabus prescribed for the course. The End Semester examination is normally a written one / Project Work / Dissertation.

(ii) The Controller of Examinations shall make necessary arrangements for notifying the dates of the End Semester examinations and other procedures as per Dibrugarh University Rules (at least 20 days in advance) and the Academic Calender notified by the University.

(iii) Normally, the End Semester examination for each course shall be of three hour duration.

(iv) Setting of question papers, moderation of question papers, evaluation of answer scripts, scrutiny, tabulation of marks, etc. and announcement of results, shall be governed by the Dibrugarh University Examination Ordinance 1972 (as amended up to date)

(c) Betterment Examination

(i) A student shall be entitled to take the betterment examinations only once in any two theory courses of any of the six semesters after passing the sixth semester examination. In this case, the higher marks secured by the student shall be retained. The candidate shall have to apply for betterment examination within one year of passing the sixth semester examination.

(ii) No betterment shall be allowed in the practical examinations.

(iii) Any difficulty which may arise in the course of operation of these regulations relating to commencement of examinations shall be met up by the Examination Committee of the Dibrugarh University.

Degrees shall be offered to each candidate, who has passed the three year degree B.A./B.Com Programme in the following manner :

(f) General Rules for Maintenance of Discipline among Students

(i) All the students of the college are required to maintain a high standard of discipline and obey the rules and regulation of the college.

(ii) The students admitted to the college must abide by all rules and regulations as prescribed by the college authorities. Violation of rules, unsatisfactory progress, irregular attendance, irregular clearance of college fees, showing discourtesy to the teachers and other members of the staff in any form, adoption of unfair means during examination etc., are some of the offences which may make students liable for disciplinary action like imposition of fine, non-award of college certificate, forced transfer and even expulsion from the college.

(iii) All forms of ragging in the college campus are prohibited. Strong disciplinary action, as the college authorities deem fit, (following the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India) may be taken if anyone is found to be involved directly or indirectly in ragging.

(iv) UNIFORM : The following garments are prescribed as the College Uniform for the students
(i) White shirt and black full pant for boys; and (ii) blue Kurta, white Pyzama and white Dopatta or white Chadar Mekhela with blue border and Blue blouse for girls.

Every instance of violating the uniform will be penalized with a fine of Rs. 100/-

(v) The courses offered by Sarupathar College are full time courses. No student can take any other full time course simultaneously.

(vi) Student societies and associations may be formed subject to rules and regulations prescribed by the college administration from time to time.

(vii) Only such societies and associations recognized by the Head of Institution can avail the facilities within college premises.

(viii) Any notice desired to be pasted or circulated by the students anywhere in the college premises needs approval of the college authority.

(ix) Use of mobile phones inside college campus is strictly prohibited. In case of detection of violating the rule, his or her guardian will be called for.

(x) All powers of maintenance of discipline are vested with the Head of the Institution and his decisions are final in all matters.

(g) Renewal of Fees

Students promoted to Higher Secondary second year and B.A./B.Com to next semester classes on the basis of result declared by AHSEC/D.U. shall have to deposit college fees at the cash counter within two weeks of the declaration of results. The exact date will be notified by the office of the Principal.

(h) College Identity Card and its Renewal

College Identity Cards are issued annually. Old Identity Card is to be surrendered at the end of each academic session for renewal.

FACILITIES

(a) College Library & Library Rules :

The College has a rich Library with a collection of exceeding 10,000 volumes of books, journals and reference books. It has an enriched subscription of journals, newspapers and magazines catering to the needs of faculty and students. The library has a furnished reading room accommodating faculty and students. The students must abide by the rules of the Library

a. Students must take Library Card for borrowing books. Two books can be borrowed at a time for a period not exceeding 15 (fifteen) days. Books issued can be recalled at any time in case of urgency by the Librarian.

b. Library Card are not transferable.

c. A fine of twenty five (25) paise per book per day will be charged, if the borrowers fail to return the books on due date and Rs. 1.00 per day thereafter will be imposed.

d. Requisition slip must be submitted before one day of issuing the books from the Library.

e. Reference books, newspaper, periodicals and question papers are not allowed to be taken out of the Library. Question papers are available for copying only.

f. Silence should be maintained in the Library. The Reading Room remains open during the college routine hours.

g. Students must return the library books before filling up the Examination Form. No students will be allowed to fill up the Examination Form without Library Clearance Certificate.

h. The Librarian shall bring it to the notice of the Principal, if any student is found to have damaged or misused books, made noise or misbehaved in any other way will make the student liable to disciplinary action.

i. Books will have to be replaced from any source if lost, torn or mutilated in any other way.

j. The students may bring to the notice to the Librarian their grievances if any.

k. The College Library remains open on all working days of the College from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

l. The days for borrowing of library books may be fixed by the librarian as per convenience.

N.B. : The facility of photocopying books, Question papers and other documents is also available in the library at a subsidized rate.

(b) IQAC

The college has an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) which monitors various academic, non-academic and co-curricular activities of the college. The cell keeps correspondence with the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) and submits Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) to the NAAC. The cell conducts annual departmental inspection of all the teaching departments and prepares academic report which is submitted to the principal. It also monitors the activities of different cells, committees, clubs, student achievements and other quality enhancement activities.

(C) BOOK BANK

The College has the facility of a Book Bank for the benefit of the poor students. It is a provision for lending text books only to the economically backward students on merit basis. To avail the benefit of the same students will have to apply in a given form to be collected from the Librarian showing a Certificate of Income from the local S.D.C. or Mauzadar or producing the B.P.L. Card. The beneficiaries will be selected purely on merit basis from among the applicants. The text book will be issued for one academic year in case of students of Higher Secondary Classes and one semester in case of Degree students and the same will have to be returned by the beneficiaries before the issuing of the admit cards for the final examination.

(D) DEPARTMENTAL LIBRARY

The members of the teaching staff have at their own initiative launched a modest effort towards establishing eight departmental libraries for the benefit of the students of each department. Emphasis is laid on improving the departmental Libraries with more collection of reference books.

(E) FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR POOR AND MERITORIOUS STUDENTS

A Student Aid-Fund was established in 2002 in order to provide some financial assistance to meritorious students coming from economically weaker sections of the society. To raise this fund an annual collection of Rs. 20/- from each student is made. The Aid-Fund Committee, after taking into consideration all aspects of the applications, decides the amount of aid to be given to a particular students. Aid will be given to students who are not only poor but also meritorious, regular in attendance and have good performance in extra-curricular activities.

(F) SCHOLARSHIP & AWARD

- a. SC/ST Scholarship.
- b. OBC/ MOBC/TGL scholarship. Scholarship is paid to the students through A/C payee cheque only.
- c. Best Student Award : An Award is decided to be given annually to a student selected as the best student through continuous observation of his/her conduct, attendance, performance in the class as well as extra curricular activities by a committee of teachers entrusted by the Principal for the purpose.
- d. The Most Regular Student Award : A student from each class is selected for the "Most Regular Student Award" for the highest percentage of attendance. The eligibility criterion for this award is minimum 85% attendance in class.
- e. Teachers of the college also offer financial support to the economically deprived students personally.

(G) COMPUTER EDUCATION

Education in computer application has been introduced as a Certificate Course for 3 (three) months in the college. Desirous students can enroll their names for the course at the cost of Rs. 450/- initially, Rs. 50/- being the admission fees and Rs. 400/- being tuition fees for the first two months. Students will have to pay Rs. 200/- as tuition fees in the last month.

Students of H.S. 1st year commerce will be given theoretical knowledge on computer application free of cost once in a week. However, interested students may enroll their names for the certificate course under the above mentioned procedure.

(H) REMEDIAL COURSES FOR SC & ST STUDENTS

A Remedial Course for the academically weak students belonging to SC and ST students has been introduced in the college to enable them to stand shoulder to shoulder with other students. The course is offered after the scheduled classes are offered.

(I) STUDENTS' UNION

Sarupathar College Students' Union is the General Body of the students of the College. Its membership is compulsory for each student of the College. Office bearers of the Union are elected annually through a democratic process. For contesting in any portfolio in the election, students must have minimum 75% attendance in the class as per the Supreme Court's direction. He must also be polite and amicable.

(J) SCOUT AND GUIDE

The college has provision for scout and guide. Students will have to face an interview to get selected in the list of 30 students for Scout and Guide. Thereafter training is imparted to selected students by the trained teachers. The scout and guide wing of the college has been displaying its attainments at various field.

(K) NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (N.S.S)

There is a National Service Scheme in the college. Students may join it to get experience in community service. The college has been interacting with rural communities through various programmes of the National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit since 1983.

(L) CAREER GUIDANCE AND COUNSELLING CELL

This Cell provides information and guidance regarding various courses, jobs and organises workshops for the upliftment of the students.

(M) U.G.C. NETWORK AND RESOURCE CENTRE

The college UGC-Network Resource Centre provides all-round facilities for accessing college Information and Communication Technology (ICT) facility. It provides free internet connectivity to students in the college hours.

(N) COACHING FOR ENTRY INTO SERVICES CELL

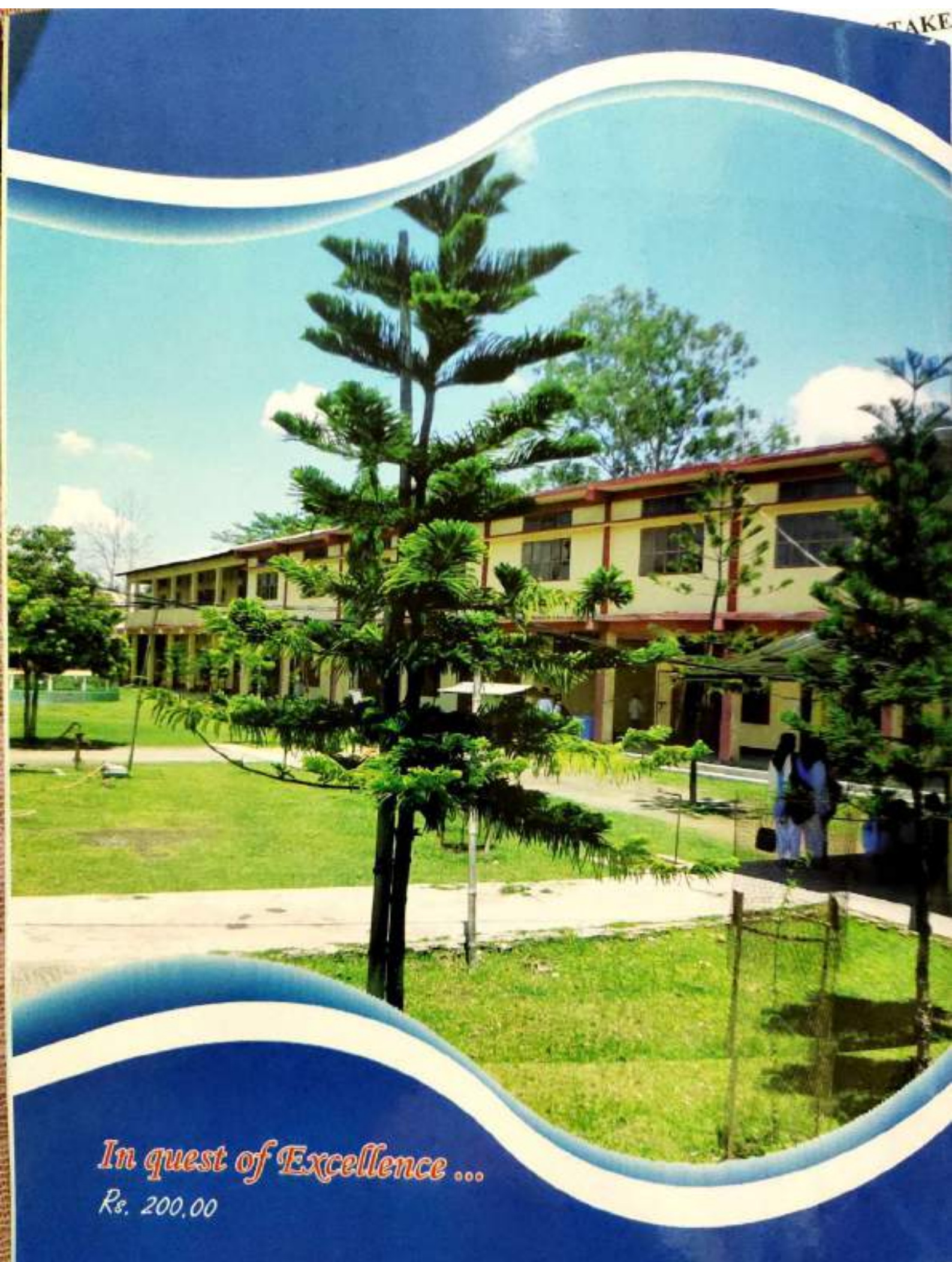

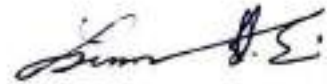
