Overview

A team from Sarupathar College, including Mr. Agni Chetry (NSS Coordinator), Mr. Parag Bhuyan, and Dr. Sanjay Rizal, visited the home of Dineswari Kardong, a solitary elderly resident in Mirigaon. This outreach was organized by the Extension and Outreach Cell in collaboration with the Department of Commerce.

Background of the Beneficiary

Dineswari Kardong, a widow for 25 years, lives in complete solitude, with no family or close friends to aid her. Her physical abilities have also declined over the years, leaving her unable to walk and fend for herself in many ways.

Objectives and Conduct of the Visit

The visit aimed to assess Ms. Kardong's living conditions and immediate needs, offering support to alleviate her isolation and lack of resources. Essential food items provided included:

- Rice
- Dal (lentils)
- Mustard oil
- Potato
- Salt

These items were carefully selected to ensure that Ms. Kardong could maintain a basic level of nutrition and sustenance. Along with providing the essential food items, the college team appreciated and motivates the local community to take care of the needy ones in their locality.

Future Commitment

In recognizing the profound isolation and challenges faced by individuals like Ms. Kardong, Sarupathar College is dedicated to extending its outreach programs to assist the impoverished and lonely segments of the community. The college is committed to ongoing efforts that aim to reach and support those who are most in need.

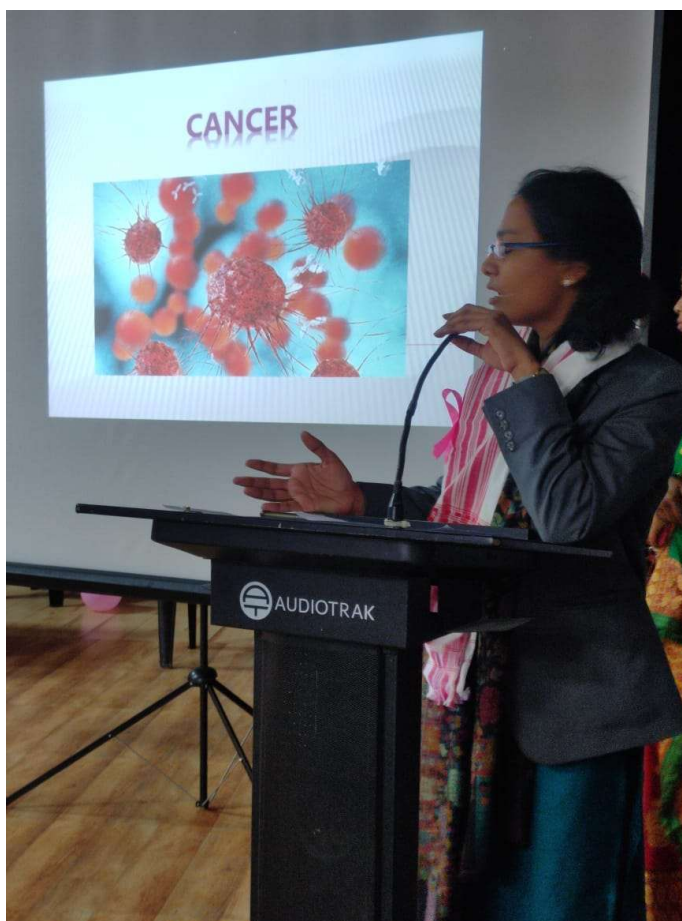


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Cancer Awareness Rally on World Cancer Day – An Extension Activity by Sarupathar College

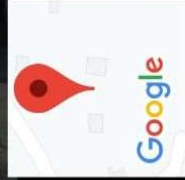

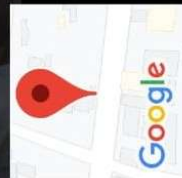
Extension Activity by Women's Cell, Sarupathar College at Sarupathar Girls' High School

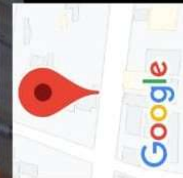

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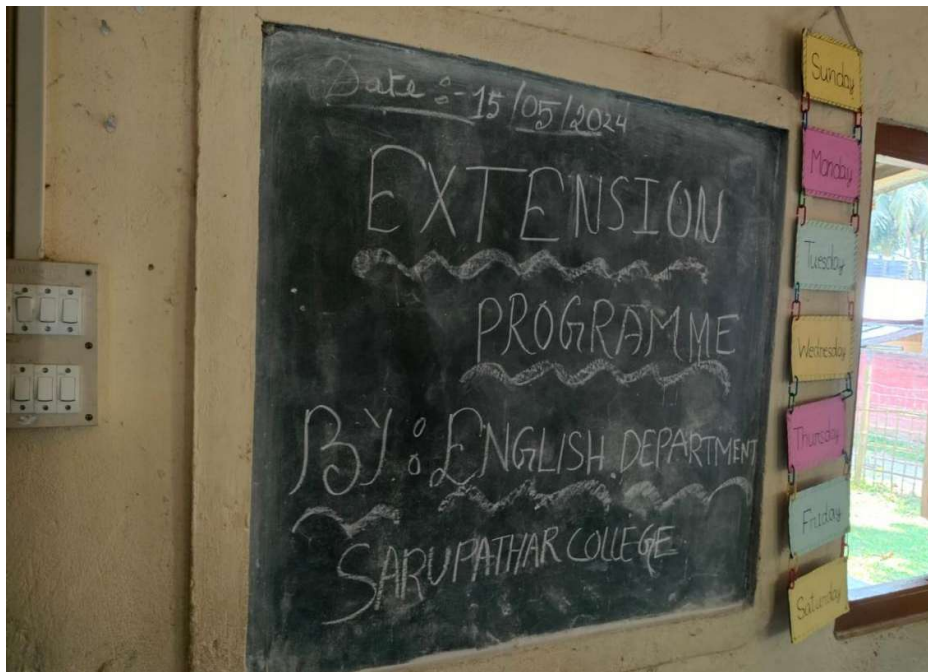


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Extension Program by Women's Cell, Sarupathar College at Padumoni M.E. School
