INSTITUTIONAL PERSPECTIVE PLAN (2022-32)

IQAC Sarupathar College holds a meeting on 4th Sept. 2022 with all the teaching and non-teaching staff and a few student representatives in presence of the Principal and chalks out the perspective plan for the upcoming ten years. The perspective plan (2022-32) has been framed as quality benchmarks for the institution. In framing it, the mission and vision of the college have been taken into consideration. Various suggestions of the stakeholders Governing body, student-community and parents have been incorporated in due place. Moreover, societal needs and locational advantages have been taken into consideration in framing this perspective plan. The institutional perspective plans are as follows:

ACADEMIC PLANS

1. To sign MOU with Kaziranga University, Assam Agricultural University, JDSG College, Eastern Karbi Anglong College, Mariani College, ITI, Barpathar and ICT Academy and other Institutions of Higher education.

2. To introduce 20 ADD-ON Courses for skill development of the students.
3. To introduce post-graduate programmes in college.
4. Effective implementation of Mentoring.
5. To introduce vocational courses such as Yoga, Diploma in Computer Application, Diploma in Tea Management and Diploma in Fishery Management etc.
6. The college will have training centres in bee keeping, poultry farming, mushroom production, fish production under the strategic 'Kaushal Bharat Yojana' of the govt. of India.
7. To conduct more Career counselling and Coaching programmes for entry into services & higher studies for advanced learners.
8. The college will establish a Museum with the help of students and local people. The museum will preserve archaeological remains of Dayang Dhansiri valley and cultural remains of North East India.
9. To introduce skill-based courses like Beautician course and saloon, doll making, Jute items making and ornamental design courses for students to enable them earn while they learn.
10. A publication cell should be opened in the college to publish books and research papers of teachers and students.
11. To establish a lab for Education Department for their educational purpose.
12. There are plans to establish study centre like Bhupen Hazarika study centre, Kushal Konwar study centre and Bhabani Study centre in college premises.
13. Under institution innovation council, the college will introduce a new cell for training the educational institutions in the neighbouring areas.
14. All the departments will organise national seminars, workshops and other training programmes and develop the departmental library.

15. To introduce Sports Management Course.
16. To start B. Ed. programme.

INFRASTRUCTURE AND ADMINISTRATIVE PLANS

1. On the occasion of celebration of Golden Jubilee, the college administration will take initiative for beautification of the entire college campus.
2. To take initiative for CSR registration to receive financial assistance from the non-government funding agencies.
3. To construct digital classrooms for implementation of the NEP 2020.
4. The college will establish a modern digital library and open library for teachers and students.
5. To construct first and second floor of the college pavilion to introduce vocational courses.
6. To establish new and modern gym in the college campus for the wellness of the college fraternity.
7. To complete the college boundary wall within the session 2022-2023.
8. To initiate lemon, banana and flower plantation and vermicompost project at the college campus for the beautification and income generating purpose.
9. Renovation of college buildings and replacement of roofs.
10. To construct college guests house from the financial assistance provided by the students, teachers and non-teaching staff.
11. Renovation of college Auditorium with modern and exotic equipment.
12. Establishment of adequate solar power lighting system in the college campus for saving electricity and preserving environment.
13. Arrangement of fisheries for pisciculture in college campus.
14. To construct permanent structure for Vermicompost, poultry farm and apiculture.

15. Earth filling on the lowlands in order to construct new academic buildings.
16. Conservation of wetland and pits for environmental purposes in college premises.
17. To construct well equipped modern toilet for teachers and students.
18. To develop the infrastructure related to sports and other co-curricular activities. The institution plans to renovate the playground and construct a new indoor stadium, a volleyball court and a tennis court and to start a Sports Complex.
19. Extension of the existing Boys' hostel.
20. To construct new well-equipped Girls' and Boys' Common Rooms.
21. To construct a well-equipped conference hall.
22. To construct another open stage.
23. To provide housing facilities to faculties of the college.
24. For further extension of the institution the college plans to approach the Govt. Of Assam to provide the required land. The allotted land would be used for farming activities which will generate revenue for the institution.
25. To construct a cafeteria.
26. To construct a social welfare centre.
27. To construct a car and a bicycle stand for teachers and students.
28. To construct multiple open libraries throughout the campus.
29. To construct memorials in celebration of 50 glorious years of the institution.
30. For the conservation and preservation of some rare species of birds, the institution plans to construct artificial habitats and feeding facilities.

31. The College plans to create some models of youth dormitories of different tribes of North-East India in order to introduce the students with the rich cultural heritage of this part of the country.
32. The institution plans to construct a greenhouse for the cultivation of medicinal plants.
